Emergency button Action Strategy October 2020

Objective of the strategy

- Reduce the time of exposure of people in environments of risk.
- Reduce the interaction of people with groups beyond the labor.
- Reduce the interaction that the possible positives with other people.
- Reduce the mobility of people.
- Protect susceptible persons during periods that decrease the risk of contracting the virus.
- Reduce with this the transmission of cases and thus decrease the speed of contagion.
- Keep hospitalization levels low.

Implementation Criteria

- Saturation of the hospital system at 50%.
- Weekly incidence rate of 400 cases by symptom onset date per million inhabitants of the previous epidemiological week, dated of court cases known to the Saturday prior to publicizing the indicator.
- The measure will be implemented statewide with a suspension almost total activities during the night from **Monday to Friday from 7:00 p.m.**
- at 06:00 the next day; and during the weekends, starting on Friday at 7:00 p.m. and resuming on Monday at 6:00 a.m.

Interruption Nights.

Monday to Friday from 19:00 - 6:00 hrs.

- Taxi services (not platform)
- Funeral services
- Industry that has contracted private transport service.
- Distribution centers

Interruption Nights

Monday to Friday from 19:00 - 6:00 hrs.

- The following activities should **suspend** operations during this time span:
- Economic activities
- Cultural activities
- Recreational, social and sports activities
- Religious activities
- Public transport and transport platform service (from 8:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.

6 hrs. the next day)

Weekends interruption

Friday 7:00 p.m. until Monday 6:00 hrs.

- The activities that **may operate** because they are essential are:
- All hospital services and private or public medical teams
- Pharmacy
- Convenience and grocery stores
- Security services
- Relief and civil protection teams
- Services and support equipment for basic public and private services (energy, water, telecommunications)
- Postal Service
- Gas stations
- Insurance company adjusters
- Taxi services (not platforms)
- Funeral services
- Public transportation with restricted hours, units and only for essential personnel.
- Industry that has contracted private transport service.
- Distribution centers.

Weekends interruption

Friday 7:00 p.m. until Monday 6:00 hrs.

• The following activities should **suspend** operations during this time span:

- economic activities
- cultural activities
- Recreational, social and sports activities
- religious activities
- transport platform service
- Tianguis and markets.

Public transportation considerations

Operation at night

- The operation of Massive Transportation Systems, Transportation Conventional (transport buses), routes with special characteristics and Transport Network Companies must suspend their operation of Monday to Friday from 8 p.m., restarting at 6 a.m. following; Considering that only the circulation of transport units to arrive at their posts of confinement or areas of overnight.
- The operation of the taxi service (not Transport Network Companies or platforms) will be able to operate in a normal way by taking recommended cleaning and hygiene.

Public transportation considerations

Weekends

Starting on Friday, October 30 at 8:00 p.m. and restarting at 6 a.m. Monday, the circulation of Mass Transportation Systems and Conventional, as well as Transport Network Companies to the schedules and operation plans authorized by the Secretary of Transportation, the same that can only provide the service to the following groups of users:

- Public medical and funeral services personnel
- Public security and civil protection personnel
- Transportation services for private personnel

The operation of the taxi service (not Transport Network Companies or platforms) will be able to operate in a normal way by taking recommended cleaning and hygiene.

Summary

- In accordance with the increase in the indicators established by the health committee, it is time to put a brake on the pace and growth of contagions. It was studied with the learning obtained that it is not necessary for the moment, to stop all economic activity, if not to slow down the one that corresponds mainly to the age groups that are currently being infected.
- Therefore, during a period of 14 days beginning this Friday, October 30 at 7:00 p.m., you are invited to all commerce, services not essential, sale in open spaces and markets not to exercise activities for two weekends and for 10 calendar days from Monday to Friday, stop non-essential activities from 7:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. the next day.
- To do so, on weekends all economic, cultural, social, recreational, sports and religious activities will be suspended.

- * Public transport and the transport platform service will also be affected, from Friday from 8:00 p.m. to Monday at 6:00 a.m.
- hours operations will be suspended and there will only be service for the personnel of the public medical area, private personnel transports, funeral homes, public safety and civil protection.
- While during the week, the public transport service will be suspended from 8:00 p.m. and will restart at 6:00 a.m. following.
- Taxis may work normally as long as they comply with health protocols.
- Established businesses and services that will be able to continue with their activities uninterruptedly are: hospitals, medical teams private or public, pharmacies, convenience stores and groceries, distribution centers, industry with transport of contracted personnel, security services, relief teams and civil protection, services and support teams of public and private basic services, postal service, gas stations, insurance company adjusters, taxis (not platform) and funeral homes.
